GEEZER was off alertly to view between runners along the backstretch, tapped on the brakes at the half mile marker when leader came over to the rail, took aim between runners at the quarter pole, and fought bravely through the stretch to edge away late on the inside. SUPERNAL stalked four wide on the backstretch, ranged up on the outside two wide through the turn, bid for the lead at the five-sixteenths, and ran gamely down the lane between runners to be second. SEE THROUGH IT chased four wide through the turn, joined the leaders at the top of the stretch in the four path, ran willingly down the lane but could not pass the top two. MIO BAMBINO was a step slow at the break but advanced along the rail to vie with the leaders, lost ground around the turn to be behind runners, angled into the five path in the stretch and made a mild gain. IT'S A FACTOR chased at the rear of the field, was in the two and three path around the turn, but lacked a rally through the lane. ITS A CINCH vied in the three and two paths between runners, angled to the rail as they entered the stretch but faded from there.
