MR. MACHUPICCHU vied three deep up the backstretch, chased after the top pair into the turn, re-bid from outside around the bend, fought in the four path turning for home, took over in upper stretch, kicked clear and drew away into the final furlong, then held safely over the late run from the runner-up. TAMARANDO BEACH chased widest up the backstretch, came six wide into the lane, showed late effort and closed the gap on the winner. HURRICANE WAY settled off the rail then angled inside near the half-mile pole, saved ground through the turn, offered up a mild late kick and gained the show honors. BAZOOKA CHARLIE vied inside a pair of rivals in the early going, dueled into the turn, fought with outer pair late on the bend, yielded in upper stretch and weakened. HANKERING vied between early then dueled leaving the backstretch, fought between rivals again late on the bend, entered the lane in the three path and weakened down the lane. BAD UNCLE ERNIE stalked the top trio from well off the rail early, took aim in the five path around the turn and weakened in the drive. NINETEENTH HOLE trailed on the inside into the turn, eased out to the three path around the bend and was never a factor.
