TRUSTY RUSTY pressed from outside, three deep on the backstretch, dueled past the three-eighths pole, fought three wide into the lane, battled down the stretch and dug in to outfinished LOW EXPECTATIONS late. LOW EXPECTATIONS showed the way under pressure from outside, held a short lead at the half-mile pole, dueled past the three-eighths marker, battled into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. MANIATIC (IRE) broke a step slow, trailed in the two path around the first turn, moved forward on the backstretch, chased two then three wide on the far turn, moved out in the drive and finished willingly to earn the show. VERITAS AEQUITAS stalked in the three path, trailed two wide into the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, kept trying down the lane but needed to find more. SMOOTH SALUTE bobbled leaving the gate, stalked from inside, bid inside midway up the backstretch, fought to the three-eighths pole, then failed to kick on with the leaders and weakened down the lane. CLOUSEAU chased two wide early, moved out on the backstretch, rounded the far turn four then five wide and weakened.
