INVINCIBLE set the pace under pressure from both sides, held a short lead over INFAMOUS ANGEL around the bend, shook free at the three-sixteenths pole and drew away. INFAMOUS ANGEL pressed three deep to the turn, kept the pressure on INVINCIBLE from outside around the turn and into the lane, failed to keep up at the three-sixteenths pole and stayed on to secure second. RHINO pulled early behind the leader, chased two, three, then four wide around the bend and churned on for the show honors. UNBREAKABLE TRUST chased from inside, swung out leaving the turn and kept on for a minor placing. RING GENERAL got crowded a bit early and trailed up the backstretch, saved ground around the bend and failed to menace. BLUE SILVER raced up close four deep, moved into the three path on the turn, came back out into the lane and weakened. LITTLEBROTHERJOEY broke in, pressed from inside, failed to keep up early on the turn and chased to the stretch, then weakened in the lane.
