THINK FAST tracked the early pace four wide, chased the pacesetter into the turn then vied to upper stretch, took command into the lane, drew off into the final sixteenth and was ridden out in the late stages. BACKSTRETCH ROSE unhurried in the early stages, weaved through rivals to upper, could not impact the winner into the final sixteenth but finished well to earn the place honors. TAP DANCIN COWGIRL tracked five wide to turn, chased to the quarter marker and was set down into upper stretch, could not keep pace with the winner into the lane and was outkicked for second in deep stretch. LOVE YOU MORE squeezed at the start, advanced inside of rivals approaching the turn, chased three to four wide nearing the quarter marker, could not find more into the

stretch drive and flattened out late. NEXT GIRL allowed to settle in the early going, coaxed three wide to the quarter marker, swung four wide to upper stretch and passed tiring rivals late. TALK TO THE JUDGE was forwardly placed while inside of rivals early on, lost position along the bend, could not find more to upper stretch and tired in the drive. ITSAMONSTAMASH raced close up to the early pace while three wide and between rivals, chased the pace into the turn, was outkicked to upper stretch then weakened in the drive. SMOKIN' HOT KITTY allowed to settle, coaxed two wide to the quarter marker and did not factor in the stretch. DOUBLE AIRO hustled for the early lead, set the pace off of the rail into the turn, showed the way to the quarter marker then was overtaken to upper stretch and faded in the drive. BRAQUET was crowded at the start and off slowly, lacked early speed, raced two to three wide to the quarter marker and did not threaten in the stretch. I'M A CUTIE PIE raced close up to the early pace while between runners, chased the pace two wide nearing the quarter marker, could not find the needed response into the stretch and gave way.
