SHE'S NO UNCLE, quickly cleared, was nicely rated just off the inside, handled outer pressure leaving the three eighths, spurted back away past the five sixteenths, responded to firm asking in upper stretch to open up then was kept busy to the wire. MOPO, three wide and between runners early on, exchanged a bump with READY FOR MAGIC in the vicinity of the five eighths, dropped inside for the run around the turn, briefly angled out then altered back in near the three sixteenths, finished up with good effort and was well clear of the rest. BREWMASTER, forwardly placed between rivals nearing the turn, chased to the inside of a foe past the three eighths, eased out a bit and closed in between runners leaving mid stretch, dueled, drifted out very late while gaining a narrow advantage and prevailed. BYE BYE WICKED EYE, soundly bumped at the break, recovered and edged up towards the inside of rivals to stalk, eased back off outer foes leaving the three eighths, came off the inside and moved up behind the leaders nearing mid stretch, swung out soon after, closed gamely and just missed outside foes. IMPERIAL SPY, three deep chasing near the half, shifted out five wide for the drive, ranged up and gained a slim lead outside runners near the sixteenth marker, dueled, was floated out by the winner in deep stretch then missed between horses. WE CALLED SOL bore in at the break bumping a rival, corrected and showed speed and prompted three wide, bid to engage the leader into the turn, dueled on a short lead past the five sixteenths, kicked clear under a drive in upper stretch, was joined by a host of outer foes leaving mid stretch then gave way grudgingly. HONORS DUE sped to the front, set the pace towards the inner rail, dueled around the turn, could not quite match strides with the leader past the three sixteenths but held quite well through the final furlong. WORLD ON FIRE, urged off the pace and off the inside, failed to respond. ANDY'SBOURBONGUY broke slowly and was outrun.
