DOLICE VITA , rated four deep on the first turn, stalked the pace outside horses down the backstretch, circled the far turn three wide, secured command in upper stretch then drew away while kept to his business. DIVINE ARMOR stayed along the inner rail down the backstretch and on the far turn, swung four wide in upper stretch, raced outside horses and passed tired ones. COFFEEWITHCHRIS , in the three path around the first turn, chased the pace, raced in the two path and dropped back some on the far turn then passed tired horses late. RHUMJAR advanced along the inner rail near the five eighths pole to press the pace, saved ground on the far turn while under urging, remained along the rail in the stretch and tired. KICK STARTNESS , clear the first turn, was kept in the two path down the backstretch and around the far turn while setting a pressured pace and gave way in upper stretch.

CORINGA stalked the pace down the backstretch and on the turn, advanced two wide under confident handling to take command entering the stretch, was under hand urging in mid stretch and drew away. PILOTE COMETE , a forward factor along the inner rail around the turn, moved to the two path at the head of the stretch, was forced to alter course to the four path in mid stretch after being behind horses then rallied willingly. LET'S GO J J , three deep chasing the pace around the turn and in upper stretch, gave way grudgingly in the drive. KARMA'S INTHEHOUSE , taken to the inner rail after sprinting clear early, remained along the rail and weakened through the stretch. CAROLINA FLAKE steadied leaving the chute, was not a factor. WRIGHTSVILLE , a forward factor in the two path between horses leaving the backstretch, faltered mid way on the turn.

EVERETT'S SONG , four deep the first turn, stalked the pace down the backstretch, was under some urging on the far turn, moved up three wide entering the stretch, gained a short lead in upper stretch and dug in tenaciously to prevail. AGARRAMESIPUEDES saved ground the first turn while well off the pace, advanced four deep leaving the far turn, challenged for the lead outside the winner in upper stretch and continued gamely. MORNING THOUGHTS , three wide both turns, chased the pace, bid for the lead on the far turn and weakened the final furlong. SPEARGUN raced in the two path on the far turn, moved to the four path in mid stretch and had a slight rally. WALK AWAY JOE stayed along the inner rail on both turns, eased out in mid stretch and needed more. QUINCANNON remained along the inner rail, disputed the pace to upper stretch and weakened. CLOUD MUSIC disputed the pace in the two path to the three eighths pole then gave way.

ALL THE HARDWAYS bumped with TOP BLOOD at the start, stalked the pace along the rail down the backstretch, eased out to the two path mid way on the far turn, took command turning for home, drifted back to the inner rail in upper stretch, was under brisk urging in the drive and switched to his left lead late. GUN TRADER raced in the two path the first turn, chased the pace between horses down the backstretch, was three wide the far turn, remained on his left lead in the stretch and gained the place. HOT STOTT disputed the pace racing in the two path and between foes around the turn and to mid stretch, led late and narrowly prevailed. BLO BY'EM , steadied in close quarters after a slow start, was shuffled back leaving the backstretch, raced along the rail on the turn, eased out for the drive, moved up in the five path in upper stretch and closed gamely outside horses after being bumped and forced out by LATIN REBEL in mid stretch. NIGHT PREACHER , rated down the backstretch, stayed along the inner rail on the turn, steadied when blocked in upper stretch then impeded outside horses when steered to the four path in mid stretch. GENERAL MAXIMUS chased the pace down the backstretch, moved up three deep leaving the turn, gained a short lead in upper stretch and weakened in the drive. WINNING TRIP hugged the inner rail, disputed the pace and weakened late. LATIN REBEL stalked the pace while two wide on the turn, swung to the four path entering the stretch and was bumped and forced out by NIGHT PREACHER in mid stretch. Following a stewards' inquiry and an objection by the rider of LATIN REBEL, NIGHT PREACHER was disqualified and placed sixth.
