PALACIOS broke inwardly, settled in behind the leaders along the inside, switched out on the turn, came past the quarter pole five wide, gained steadily to take the lead passing the furlong marker, drew clear. CASEOFTHEMONDAYS set the early tempo from outside then settled to press the inside foe, duelled with that one taking command at the seven-sixteenths, drew just clear near the quarter pole turning into upper stretch, was no match for the winner. OUR DAY WILL COME appeared to brush the gate and outside foe at the start, pursued from outside a foe in the second flight, advanced three to four wide on the turn, needed more. FEELS SO RIGHT brushed lightly with a rival at the start, pressed from inside, dueled into the turn, gave way. PAUL'S GUITAR dropped back outside foes early, was outrun and never a threat.
