ZEVON assumed the early lead and moved towards the inner rail, set a comfortable pace, was well clear in mid stretch and dug in late. ALAKAN stalked the pace inside horses, moved off the rail turning for home, worked through narrow quarters near the eighth pole and closed. PUNXSUTAWNEY PHIL , four

wide the first turn, remained outside horses down the backstretch, circled the far turn four wide, was well placed in upper stretch and flattened out. EDGERTON , steadied when shuffled back entering the first turn, was well off the pace down the backstretch and into the far turn, swung to the seven path in upper stretch and rallied outside foes. DRILLING FOR GOLD , pinched back leaving the starting gate, lost ground the far turn, moved to the six path in upper stretch and rallied between rivals. EL TINMARIN bore out leaving the starting gate, worked between horses in the stretch and lacked a rally. HANKSDIVININGROD lacked speed, was checked in tight quarters along the inner rail approaching the stretch then passed tired rivals. SPRING DECISION hugged the inner rail stalking the pace and weakened through the stretch. RESPIGHI chased the winner to the stretch and gave way the final furlong. BEEKMAN STREET , forced out leaving the starting gate, worked between horses turning for home and in the stretch and failed to rally. KORU , four wide both turns, floated to the five path in upper stretch and gave way. WALDRIP remained along the inner rail, checked leaving the far turn and gave way.
