LIFTING cleared early and set a rated pace off the inside, turned away outer threats nearing the half, moved away in upper stretch and held firm under a drive. EDELWEISS, five wide advancing outside foes nearing the half, failed to quicken with the winner soon after, shifted in with pursuit and held well to be clearly second best. CHRISTMAS SPIRIT steadied when in close at the start, regrouped to be well off the early pace, angled out around the turn, circled five wide with some progress into the stretch, chased on past mid stretch then flattened out late. TACTICS edged up inside nearing the three quarter pole and chased, angled out nearing the lane, shifted back inside through the drive but came up empty. LIKE TYSON stalked between runners and faded. FIRST OFFICER, three and four wide between rivals nearing the half, gave way. UNCLE GREY lagged back, raced very wide in upper stretch and failed to menace.
