LIMO assumed the early lead, remained along the rail under confident handling, was challenged leaving the far turn, responded and held a clear advantage through the stretch while kept to his business. NAABAHHII hugged the inner rail down the backstretch and around the far turn, eased out to the two path turning for home and rallied between horses. MASTER SOMMELIER, a forward factor outside the winner down the backstretch and on the far turn, took aim on the lead entering the stretch and weakened in the drive. PENDAR squeezed back soon after the break, raced along the inner rail on the far turn and in upper stretch, altered out in mid stretch and closed between rivals. MARGIE'S LAST hugged the inner rail, stalked the leader to mid stretch and weakened. SCANNER bore out and was rank leaving the starting gate, was eager to run three wide around the first turn, remained in range to the stretch and tired. DRIVE BY JOHNNY, steadied when rank at the start, raced widest in the stretch and finished with interest. MUNNY PROBLEM raced in mid pack down the backstretch and on the far turn, swung four wide in upper stretch and gave way. ZENCAT, three wide both turns, weakened. CHATBOT was outrun. OCEAN SOUND, outrun, dropped back.
