SELL IT chased outside RETURN FIRE, overtook that one in upper stretch and went clear then dug in late. MR. FUNTASTICO , close up between horses on the first turn, encountered traffic entering the far turn, waited for room mid way on the bend, advanced between horses in upper stretch then closed outside the winner. CELTIC PRINCE , four wide the first turn, stalked outside horses down the backstretch, took aim on the lead turning for home and flattened out. BREWMASTER stalked the pace inside horses to the stretch, swung outside and lacked the needed late effort. SNEAKING SUSPICION , steadied when pinched back leaving the starting gate, was rank behind horses entering the first turn, worked between horses and finished willingly.

RETURN FIRE set an easy pace along the inner rail and gave way in upper stretch. TRIATHELON raced in mid pack and failed to rally. MAUPANSANT , outside horses for the stretch run, was never a factor. BLACKTHORNE BRUSCA , four wide the first turn, was no factor and steadied between horses in upper stretch. LOMAX , five wide the first turn, remained wide on the far turn and was outrun. TACTICS , slow to begin, was outrun. WHITE BLUE was outrun.
