LONGHI , checked in tight quarters soon after the break, raced along the inner rail on the far turn, swung to the four path in upper stretch, closed determinedly outside horses and was up approaching the finish. PATRICK'S PROMISE , in tight quarters leaving the starting gate, moved up in the three path leaving the far turn, challenged for the lead outside MR FLOWERS in mid stretch, led late and finished gamely inside the winner. MR FLOWERS accelerated to the front and moved to the inner rail on the first turn, set the pace along the rail to mid stretch and weakened late. FULLY BOOKED lacked speed, remained along the rail on the far turn and in the stretch, altered course near the sixteenth pole and finished willingly. WINE COLLECTOR circled the first turn three wide, remained in the three path on the far turn and failed to rally in an even effort. SOUPER CRUNCHY prompted outside MR FLOWERS and gave way in the drive. VILLAIN came in at the break, was four deep leaving the backstretch and faltered. ARMED N DANGEROUS stumbled at the break, hugged the inner rail for five furlongs, faltered and was eased.
