## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

NANCIE'S BOY chased the pace three wide around the turn, bid for the lead outside QUAMASH in upper stretch, dueled through the lane, bumped with QUAMASH inside the sixteenth pole and determinedly prevailed. QUAMASH, bumped on both sides leaving the starting gate, sped to the front, was near the rail on the turn, battled inside NANCI'S BOY, drifted out and bumped with that one inside the sixteenth pole and just missed in a game effort. ALL FRUITS RIPE drifted in in front of horses leaving the backstretch, stayed off the rail chasing the pace and finished evenly. DAVE THE GREAT, fractious behind the starting gate, bumped with QUAMASH leaving the starting gate, saved ground on the turn chasing the pace and weakened. FURIOUS GEORGE, checked in close quarters behind ALL FRUITS RIPE leaving the backstretch, was not a factor. COURAGEOUS MISSION bore in bumping QUAMASH leaving the starting gate, was checked when pinched back soon after the start then was outrun. ROYAL FLUSH HEARTS drifted in soon after the break and was no factor. MORAL DISTORTION was checked in tight quarters along the inner rail leaving the backstretch.
