MO'S GLITTER bore out leaving the starting gate, accelerated to the lead, remained near the inner rail around the turn and held sway under brisk urging. COUNTRY BUMPKIN, steadied behind the winner soon after the start, circled the turn four wide, rallied nicely and bore in when racing greenly approaching the sixteenth pole. IMPRESSIVENESS chased three wide on the turn and was checked and forced in when shut off by COUNTRY BUMPKIN approaching the sixteenth pole. HARD FREEZE, five deep leaving the turn, passed tired horses. SKULLDUGGERY chased the winner, weakened and was forced in approaching the sixteenth pole. PENCIL ME IN, caught in close quarters leaving the starting gate, was no factor. FIVE MINUTES MORE, steadied behind the winner leaving the starting gate, hugged the inner rail was no factor. PATUXENT, lightly steadied in traffic entering the turn, was no factor. Following a stewards' inquiry and an objection by the rider of IMPRESSIVENESS, COUNTRY BUMPKIN was disqualified and placed third. An objection by the rider of COUNTRY BUMPKIN against the winner for alleged interference leaving the staring gate was not allowed.
