## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

WONDER GIRL stalked two to three wide, edged up under a ride into the lane, forged clear under a right handed drive in mid stretch then steadily widened while kept alert. GOLDEN CAN chased three wide, circled four wide into the lane, ranged up nearing mid stretch, switched over to her left lead and dug in to save the place. BEST KISS YET drifted in at the break tightening foes, rated off the pace, raced between foes leaving the three eighths, shifted out for a clear run near mid stretch and closed steadily. SOCIAL WHIRL had speed then rated back off the leaders in the opening furlong, raced forwardly saving ground mid turn, eased out into the lane, worked between foes near the sixteenth pole, dropped back in then flattened out. SPOILS OF WAR, in tight at the break, regrouped and rated off the pace and outside a rival, steadied when blocked with run behind foes in mid stretch, swung out near the sixteenth pole and finished with good energy. CHIPOTLE PEPPER came out at when rank at the break brushing a rival, steadied along when rank into the turn, remained tough to settle around the turn, eased out for the drive, steadied lacking room near mid stretch and faded. AFANDI broke a step slow, saved ground off the pace then steadied with run when bottled up leaving mid stretch. SMALLTOWNSMOKESHOW, brushed at the break, was sent clear early, set the pace towards the inside, failed to resist the winner leaving the three sixteenths and weakened. WATCH ME DISAPPEAR, pinched back at the break, circled the turn four wide and faded.
