TOUPIE leaned in hitting the gate, recovered and was patiently handled off the pace and towards the inside, edged up along the inner rail soon into the lane, eased out and forged through between rivals leaving the furlong grounds to take command, spurted clear while switching to her correct lead with about a sixteenth to go then held firm while steadily hand ridden to the wire. LIFELOVENLAUGHTER, well placed saving ground under rating, eased out with an advance soon into the stretch, moved up and took a slim lead outside foes with a furlong remaining, failed to contain the winner from her inside but stayed gamely to be well clear of the rest. LOON CRY broke a step slow, regrouped and settled off the pace while saving ground, angled out to be three to four wide into the stretch, shifted back in near mid stretch, advanced between foes then kept on with good energy to gain the show to the inside of FLAMINGO WAY. FLAMINGO WAY, away well, stalked the loose leader while nudged along, shifted four wide and gained past the quarter pole, chased leaving the furlong grounds and gave way grudgingly. ALLA BREVE broke slowly, saved ground off the pace, worked outward for the final furlong but failed to generate

a serious rally. SALLY'S GOLD sped clear early, opened up her advantage saving ground into the turn, remained well clear under asking in upper stretch, failed to contain outer bids in mid stretch and weakened. THE AMAZING MIZZEN, sluggish from the gate, raced well back and off the inside, circled five wide into the stretch, shifted in some past the three sixteenths then had a belated response. TWIRLING BEAUTY chased outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch, was guided further out near mid stretch and gave way. ANAITA drafted back early, circled five wide into the lane, failed to kick on leaving the quarter pole and weakened.
