VENETO cleared early and set a rated pace in the two path, denied a pair of outer foes entering the lane, spurted away on his left lead and under a drive leaving mid stretch then widened while kept to task. FURIOUS GEORGE broke inward bumping with a rival, corrected and prompted the pace three wide, challenged between runners approaching the stretch, floated out a bit while pursuing past mid stretch and kept on with good effort to save the place. COCO NO LOCO stalked four wide, ranged up and bid three deep leaving the three eighths, chased on through the lane and kept trying to the wire. PAYNTED LION , bumped at the break, edged up two wide nearing the turn, angled out around the turn, came very wide for the drive and flattened out. UNCLE GREY , in close at the break, was taken well wide early, angled in under a ride for the drive but lacked a serious finish. MAGNIFICENT RAGS was used early chasing while saving ground, failed to keep pace leaving the far turn and faltered.
