FIRST PEARL , with the pace three deep past the three quarter pole, wrested command from an inner rival leaving the half mile marker then cruised clear, remained confidently handled into the lane, kicked away after being set down near the three sixteenths then continued as much the best while steadily hand ridden the final sixteenth. MAP TO THE MOON tracked inside and behind the leading trio, steadied when in a bit close past the half, regrouped and angled out mid turn, edged up four to five wide in upper stretch then kept on with good effort to be well clear of the rest. EMPIRE'S TREAT broke outward and bumped a rival, corrected and stalked outside a foe, gave hard chase four wide into the stretch, failed to kick on near mid stretch and faded. CATARINA , bumped at the break, regrouped and settled off the pace, angled very wide for the drive and failed to muster up a solid run. STILL GAME bobbled at the break, recovered and rolled up to the inside of a pair to join the pace fray after a quarter mile, sparred on a slim lead into the turn, ceded command past the half, failed to find more approaching the stretch and retreated. WICKED MELISSA , in a bit tight at the break, lagged back and failed to get involved. PEACH TEA sped to the front and set the pace early pace two wide, was joined from both sides nearing the three quarter pole, disputed the pace to the half mile marker, faltered around the turn then was eased through the final furlong.
