KOHOUTEK came in at the break, stalked the pace three deep around the turn, advanced outside horses, challenged for the lead in mid stretch, drifted in a bit bumping with THEN WHAT TIME near the sixteenth pole and drew clear after switching leads three times the final furlong. THEN WHAT TIME bore out leaving the starting gate, showed speed three deep entering the turn, raced between horses in the stretch drive and came out a bit bumping with the winner near the sixteenth pole. NEW YORK STRONG showed speed between horses leaving the backstretch, moved to the inner rail on the turn and finished gamely. YERCAN MARO (ARG) , squeezed back at the start, circled the turn four to five wide and rallied outside horses. JUST FOR GIGGLES , steadied behind the winner leaving the starting gate, four wide on the turn, flattened out between rivals. JUS TOO FLY stayed along the inner rail around the turn and was not a factor. GOTTA HAVE A GUY , four wide on the turn, weakened in the drive. BREEZING UP hugged the inner rail leaving the backstretch, bore out entering the turn and was no factor. CAN'T STAND DISCO showed speed along the inner rail for three furlongs and gave way. NANCIE'S BOY , checked in tight quarters entering the turn, was not a factor.

WHY NOT GRACE broke sharply and established command into the first turn, dropped in and set a rated pace while being shadowed, edged clear into the far turn, was nudged along past the five sixteenths, responded to firm asking in upper stretch and steadily pulled away through the final furlong. BORN CHARMER stalked three wide between foes, ranged up to loom near the quarter pole, saw the winner kick away soon into the lane but kept on willingly to save the place. YO LEVEN prompted the pace outside the winner, shifted in and was pushed along to the inside of BORN CHARMER past the five sixteenths, remained inside for the drive and continued with effort. SHEEZAHOTMESS settled well back, angled out and was put to asking around the final turn, circled six wide into the stretch and churned on. MAP TO THE MOON saved ground, rushed up to the inside of runners nearing the half, failed to kick on under a ride leaving the three eighths, eased out and faded. EMPIRE'S TREAT lost ground four wide outside rivals and weakened. SWEET WINE stalked the pace, raced two wide between rivals nearing the far turn, lacked a kick soon after and retreated.

KING'S RIVER settled in the clear past the five eighths and off of a contested pace, eased out a bit and gathered some steam four wide into the lane, switched over to his correct lead near the furlong grounds, worked well out in the course, straightened past the sixteenth pole, closed strongly under a drive and forged ahead in the final yards. MCRAVIN , a bit headstrong through the opening furlong, relaxed better while saving ground around the first turn and into the backstretch, took closer order into the far turn, was held up behind a rival from the five sixteenths to the quarter pole, angled out into the lane, shifted back in, closed to the inside of rivals to take a brief lead past the sixteenth pole, kept on gamely but failed to match strides with the outer winner. PARACLETE rated three to four wide, advanced in hand four wide past the quarter pole, dove in a couple paths leaving the three sixteenths then churned on between runners. NOTHINGBUTBLUESKY settled well back, stayed inside into the lane, split rivals leaving the furlong grounds then ran up on foes late. PATRICK'S PROMISE saved ground, angled out approaching the stretch and faded. WHENEVERUREMEMBER stalked between foes, gained under asking leaving the three eighths, failed to kick on in upper stretch and weakened. PALLINO took over early then cleared into the first turn, dropped inside then was joined near the five eighths, dueled into and around the far turn, failed to go on while under a ride into the lane and weakened.
