STAGE LEFT settled in the middle of the tight pack along the rail, tipped out to the two path for the stretch run, and finished best under steady handling to prevail. BERGHEIM did not contest the early pace, but tucked in just behind the leaders, became boxed in as the field headed into the turn, waited for room, got a big seam to run through at the top of the stretch, closed well, and just missed. SPEIGHTSVILLE was sent to a narrow early lead with the rest in close pursuit, duled with TAKE ACTION through the turn, got the better of that one in upper stretch, battled on gamely when confronted by STAGE LEFT, and gave way grudgingly in the final yards. GUITAR BOY raced at the back but never far back, finished up well to improve a couple of spots. BLING MOUNTAIN settled three-wide off the pace, moved up to be in range of the leaders at the quarter pole, swung five-wide into the stretch, but was not doing enough late to pose a threat. TAKE ACTION pressed the early pace two-wide, then flattened out in the final furlong.
