CLOSING SPEAKER vied for the early lead near the rail and finished well to draw clear under strong handling. GAB'S HUMOR settled off the early pace, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and rallied well to get up for the place position. SOMERVILLE vied between early, dropped back a bit through the far turn, came on again and weakened a bit the final eighth of a mile. CUVEE'S BELLAROSE dropped back early on, raced four wide around the far turn and had no response. HOT DONNA pressed the pace from the outside of rivals and faded in the drive. FUND LAVENDER trailed early on, saved ground and never threatened.
