CALIBRATE was unhurried from the start and trailed the rest by a sizeable margin early on, saved ground throughout, then tipped out to the three-path at the top of the stretch and finished with a scintillating turn of foot to win going away. OCELOT , got the better of that one by mid-stretch but could not hold off the late charge of the winner. COUNTRY CAPER settled off the pace two-wide, finished with good interest but was not quite good enough. WOW THAT'S HOT came away running, but ceded the front end, was under a rating hold while in a stalking position for the first half, bided time without a clear path through the far turn, tipped out to the three path in upper stretch, but was outfinished. BRUCELEA settled at the back early, then lacked a late bid. CARLEA'S DREAM bobbed shortly after the start, but recovered quickly, took the early lead three-wide out of the chute, controlled the early pace with mild pressure to the outside from OCELOT, fought back when challenged by that foe midway through the far turn, then gave way in the final furlong.
