TEXIAN DEVIL pressed the pace to the second turn, assumed command, drew off for a clear lead and held well in a driving finish. RANGO was void of early speed, rallied around the far turn, swung wide entering the stretch and closed to get up for place. SUPERSECRETWEAPON was unhurried early, bid inside leaving the turn and finished well to earn show. MONEYLINE was hustled along inside, raced close to the pace while saving ground, advanced to the turn, bid and came up empty late. GOLD PRIZE hopped at the start, was slow early, raced inside, advanced to the turn, angled out, bid and came up empty. GHOST NATION trailed the field and improved position in a steady effort. BRILLIANT SPIN was steadied into the first turn, raced mid pack in an even effort and was not a threat. DEVIL'S MISCHIEF stalked the pace three wide, loomed a threat on the turn, dropped back and gave way. HE'S A STRIKER raced mid pack along the inside, lacked a bid and was outrun. SIPPIN SCOTCH set the pace, gave way entering the turn and stopped. ARIES HONOR was never far back, raced outside, stopped into the turn, was eased and walked off.
