VIVE VEUVE rated just off of the early pace and saved ground to the first turn, well placed while saving ground into the backstretch, saved all of the ground to the far turn then waited for racing room at the quarter marker, kept an inside path to the stretch, found a seam inside of the furlong marker then surged along the rail to the final sixteenth, took command in deep stretch and proved best. TIZAWIZ broke alertly and took early command, set a modest pace while prompted to the half-mile marker, set a contested pace to the far turn, held foes at bay to upper stretch then dug in into the final furlong, moved off of the rail into the final sixteenth, was overtaken by the winner in deep stretch and bested the rest for a game runner-up effort. MULTIPLICATION prominent away from the start, stalked the modest pace two wide to the backstretch, kept close attendance to TIZAWIZ into the far turn, battled to upper stretch then was kept at bay into the final furlong, yielded to the top two in deep stretch and was a clear third. LUCKY SPEECH away in good order, rated to the first turn then caught in tight while between rivals along that bend, settled to the backstretch run, coaxed from the two path nearing the quarter marker, angled four wide to upper stretch, no late kick. MISS METOYER lunged then broke out at the start and was last away from the gate, rushed up outside of rivals into the first turn then stalked the pace three deep into the backstretch, chased into the far turn, was outkicked to upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. LOVE YOU ANYWAY bobbed at the start and off a step slowly, was kept then shuffled back into the first turn, swung outside of rivals to the backstretch then was widest nearing the half-mile marker, ran in pursuit four wide into the far turn, could not keep pace nearing the top of the stretch and tired.
