MI AMIGA raced up the inside to take command in the first eight, opened a well measured lead under confident handling, drew away in hand in mid-stretch and was geared down late as much the best. MINNIE'S PEARLS prompted the pace to the head of the lane, was no match for the winner and finished willingly as second best. FINITO stalked the top pair for the entire trip, failed to gain ground and kept-on in the stretch to hold the show. KELBELA shuffled at the start going well wide in a crowded break, was left to be the distant trailer and showed late interest in the stretch. HELENE'S POWER broke alertly, settled to the rear of the field and went evenly. BREAKER WAVE saved ground throughout, cutting the corner turning for home to no avail. PRINCESS PEACH was through early. LEANER AND MEANER chased the leaders from four wide for a half mile and gave way.
