GOLD MESA broke alertly and assumed early command, set a pressured pace to the turn while outside of ONENITE OFMISCHIEF, shook free into the turn then held a clear lead to the stretch, was getting weary into the final sixteenth but held for the win. K K'S KAITTY EDGE hopped at the start and was off slowly, settled in the second flight then was coaxed four wide to the turn, ran in pursuit to upper stretch, was able to close into the winner's margin in the final sixteenth but could not reel that one in and held for second. HOLIDAY CRUISE prominent early then rated off of the pace, chased two wide along the turn, fought on into the stretch and was gaining in the late stages, was caught a bit in tight between the leading pair in deep stretch and was well clear of the rest for third. TROT THIS WAY hard to load, got crowded by ONENITE OFMISCHIEF when that rival broke in at the start, was off slowly then settled three wide and between rivals, shifted out nearing the top of the lane and angled widest for the stretch drive then passed tired foes. ONENITE OFMISCHIEF broke in at the start and crowded inner rival, went up to press the early pace from inside of GOLD MESA, repelled by the pacesetter into the turn and chased to upper stretch, could not find more into the drive and gave way. JOLLY GOOD TIME off a step slowly then caught in tight between foes in the early stages, settled in the second flight then saved ground heading into the turn, lacked the needed response at the quarter pole, trailed to upper stretch and tired in the lane.

SHOGUN settled off of the early leading pair and was well placed to the backstretch, coaxed two wide to the quarter marker, made a sustained rally into the stretch drive then reeled in MELLENCAMP inside of the sixteenth marker, took command into deep stretch and held for the win. MELLENCAMP broke out at the start and crowded outer rivals, wanted the early lead then vied into the first turn, shook free along the backstretch and made his own pace to the far turn, was clear to upper stretch then kept to task to the furlong pole, caught by SHOGUN in deep stretch, held for second. PROMISSIONE pinched and jostled at the start, settled off of the early pace then trailed to the half-mile pole, got bottled up a bit into the far turn, found a seam nearing the quarter marker and angled out for the stretch drive, closed willingly to the final sixteenth and just missed for second in a good effort. MARKANSAS crowded then bumped at the start and off slowly, settled outside of rivals into the backstretch, coaxed along while widest approaching the far turn, was three wide while in pursuit to upper stretch, could not impact the top three in the stretch drive and passed a tired foe in the lane. CAUSE IM THE KING broke in a bit at the start then settled off of the early pace, unhurried along the backstretch, kept a two wide path to the far turn, could not find the needed response nearing the top of the lane and did not factor late. STEEN prominent away from the start, vied for the early lead with MELLENCAMP, stalked that one to the backstretch then lost contact nearing the half-mile, ran in pursuit while saving ground into the far turn, could not find more with a furlong to go and tired in the drive. THE JOCKEY OF PROMISSIONE LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST MELLENCAMP, CLAIMING INTERFERENCE AT THE START. IN ADDITION, THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START. THE STEWARDS RULED THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE.

STAYED IN FOR HALF broke a step slowly, showed good speed and went up to dispute the early pace from the inside, vied inside of a pair of rivals while contesting solid fractions into the turn, dug in to upper stretch, held off foes into the final sixteenth and was unyielding in deep stretch for a determined win. INNOVA settled just off of the quick early pace, saved ground into the turn, waited for racing room behind rivals into upper stretch, found a seam between foes into the final furlong, surged in deep stretch and missed for the win, while just holding for the place. TRUST DADDY broke alertly, showed good speed from the gate and disputed the solid pace three deep approaching the turn, contested the pace three wide to the quarter marker then vied for the lead to upper stretch, fought gamely into the final furlong, could not muster the needed final response and was outkicked for the win and place, while just holding for the show. MARCUS GIFT threw his head then was crowded at the start and was last away from the gate, trailed to the turn, asked for run six wide to upper stretch, closed willingly in the late stages but could not reel in the leaders at the wire. CARIBBEAN DREAM away in good order, vied for the early lead from between runners then pressed the solid pace two wide into the turn, disputed quick fractions to the quarter marker and battled to upper stretch, fought on to the final sixteenth then yielded in deep stretch. BAD BEAT BRIAN forwardly placed early on, took back and tracked from the second flight, swung three then four wide to upper stretch, offered a late bid but needed more in deep stretch.
