DAAHERS BULLY dueled inside a rival for a half-mile, asserted command late. YOGURT tracked mid-pack, saved ground, rallied late, just missed. COOL RIDE dueled outside of a rival to the stretch, then weakened. SIR ELI raced three-wide and was mildly gaining in the stretch. CALEB CAT settled near the back two-wide then was mildly gaining. SAHARA SUE broke a step slow, trailed, made a mild belated rally. THIRSTY THURSDAY tracked well off-the pace and finished evenly. COLLINS AVE settled near the back and never threatened.
