QUICK MASTER led mid race, lost places going extremely wide on a turn, reasserted and regained lead before the final fence, went clear in the stretch and won driving. DECISIVE TRIUMPH led the first mile, briefly passed by QUICK MASTER mid race, led again when that one went wide. dueled with QUICK MASTER into the final fence, then out finished in the stretch. ANZIO traveled in third close up, pressed on the backstretch, kept close but out finished in the final furlong. SULTAN PIERJI (FR) traveled held up in the rear the first mile, was prominent the final half mile, then out finished. ICANDOTHAT in second early, dropped back, trailed and was eased to the wire.
