MIDNIGHT SHOW pressed the pace through the turn shaking clear in upper stretch holding firm to wire. GOLDEN COOKIE raced evenly through the turn into upper stretch rallying late as second best. CHI TOWN PRINCE pressed the pace through the turn weakening in upper stretch. DOC B slow early played no factor. BISCOTTI was never involved. AFTER SUNRISE raced evenly weakening to upper stretch. BLIND EYE was always outrun.
