R DOC prompted the pace drawing off on the far turn holding on late under inside pressure. KANTPAYTHETOLL prompted early then chased through the far turn into upper stretch gaining boldly on the inside before running out of ground. CLASSIC KING tracked the pace chasing through the lane finishing well. LUVTHEONEURWITH slow early rallied past the others. MISSION MIKE played no factor. MR HOOVER stalked the pace weakening on the far turn. READY FOR ACTION was never involved. JURA hustled along in pursuit would wilt on the far turn.
