HAPPY FRIDAY rallied on the turn drawing even abreast foe in upper stretch moving clear late. RED DRAPES chased the pace dueling in upper stretch ceding to outside pressure. PIGEON CAY pressed early then dropped off on the turn improving late with an even finish. SMART LITTLE LASS slow early raced wide to upper stretch passing tired ones late. INDEPENDENT STREAK pressed early then weakened to upper stretch. LUCKY AND PRETTY faded on the turn. GEVALIA played no factor. CAPARBIA was always outrun. LIL BRAVEHEART set the pace then wilted in upper stretch.
