## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

WILDING LANE steadying in traffic on the first turn would fire on the far turn dueling from mid track down the lane prevailing gamely. ST. EMILION rallied on the far turn dueling inside of rival down the lane battling to the wire. BOUND TO SUCCEED raced evenly circling out to upper stretch vying late six wide. COULD DO stalked the pace chasing inside to upper stretch finishing evenly. JUNIOR CHIEF gained on the far turn then weakened in upper stretch finishing evenly. DOMINATOR C. slow early played no factor. DECORATED WARRIOR rushed off led through the far turn then wilted in upper stretch. SHOOT THE WAVES failed to respond.
