PINK CHANNEL slow early lagged to upper stretch finding best stride late. LEAVE DRAMA BEHIND pressed hard through the turn tiring down the stretch. NEXT DOT raced evenly losing ground to upper stretch closing some while racing widest. THIRD TUESDAY played no factor. MAD SWANN trailed throughout.
