ONE ANNIE was bumped and in tight at the break lagging to upper stretch firing six wide there getting up with a big finish. GREAT MOON away alertly set the pace clearing into upper stretch digging in near the rail being run down at the wire. S S FLAMINGO tracked evenly giving a mild rally in upper stretch holding position late. KINGDOM'S SPIRIT in close at the break trailed through the turn saving ground to upper stretch finishing well on the rail. S S COSMOPOLITAN veered out bumping and crowding foe at the break, chased through the turn then wilted the final eighth. MORNING HOLIDAY played no factor. HO HO HO LETS GO weakened on the turn. TEXAS HOTTIE in close at the break was never involved.
