WEDDING MARCH drew even abreast foe on the turn wearing rival down in mid stretch to win going away. GREAT MOON set the pace being hooked from the outside at the quarter pole dueling in upper stretch being overpowered mid stretch holding up for place inside. MISS LITTLE BIT lagged to upper stretch moving up while racing wide there. STRAWBERRY SKY slow early lost ground to upper stretch passing a few there racing wide. KETO FRIENDLY played no factor. BITCOIN BABY pressed early then faded to upper stretch. ALMOND FUDGE flashed early speed then faded on the turn. VOSTRA was always outrun.
