KHOZANDO rallied on the far turn drawing clear late uner a drive. HIGH ROLLING DUDE stalked the pace bidding clear to upper stretch being run down late. CAPTAIN CREED gave a middle move bidding five wide on the far turn weakening in deep stretch. HAPI HAPI slow early gained some on the far turn then faded in upper stretch. CAVENDISH pressed the pace dueling through the far turn wearing out in upper stretch. ROSE'S PEPINO far back early was no factor. MAJOR CONTENDER pressed the pace through the far turn tiring in upper stretch.
