RANGER THUNDERBOLT (IRE) led in the clear from start to finish, increased margin easily. ARMY TIMES settled in third, finished well, was best of others for second. CARNANE (IRE) rated held up, rallied on the backstretch, made a steady gain for third. REGAL KINGDOM rated held up, rallied on the backstretch to gain third, stayed on for fourth. MAINSTREAM SELLOUT trailed. BOURBON OUTLAW traveled mid pack, dropped back coming out of the final turn. KAJUS was never a threat, dropped back and was pulled up. LADSFIRSTLOVE dropped back and was pulled up. LIGHTUP LIGHTUP tracked the leader in second, stopped on the backstretch and was pulled up.
