CROSSOVER CAPITAL (FR) broke a step slow, pulled in the early stages, then settled off the pace inside, moved up two wide entering the far turn, swung wide turning for home, responded when asked, closed willingly outside rivals, charged to the front and kicked away under urging. MISTBORN broke outward, raced off the pace inside, advanced inside on the far turn, rallied on the rail in the stretch run and finished well for the place spot. OLATZ (GB) pulled in the early stages, settled off the pace inside leaving the clubhouse turn, chased inside on the far turn, rallied between horses at the furlong marker and was outkicked. JUST TELL ANNE raced two wide off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid and was outkicked. PAYNTERPRETTY tracked the pacesetter, bid between rivals on the far turn, steadied in a bit tight at the top of the lane, then weakened. TIME FOR YOU showed good early speed to set the pace, responded when challenged, dug in to midstretch, then tired. TOO MANY MIKES raced two wide off the pace and did not factor. DARK BLUE WATER hopped at the start and was outrun.

LIKA ROLLING STONE raced two wide off the pace, chased on the far turn, rallied four wide into the stretch, bid at the furlong marker and dug in gamely outside to the finish. IVY GIRL trailed the field, made a rail bid on the far turn, then was in tight and shuffled back midway on the turn, moved up inside entering the stretch, rallied on rail and dug in gamely to the finish. FLOWERS FOR ME was off slowly, stalked three wide, bid four wide on the far turn, led at the quarter pole, dueled and weakened in the final furlong.
