GOVERNOR SAM showed good early speed racing two wide, dueled on the turn, responded when roused, took charge in upper stretch, kicked clear under urging and was kept to the task. SOUPER QUEST chased inside, chased on the turn, rallied between horses in the stretch run and dug in gamely to earn the place award. COPPOLA chased between rivals early on, dropped back on the turn, rallied in the two path in the stretch run and finished well inside. ALOGON bobbed at the break, raced off the pace, chased three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid outside rivals at the eighth pole and was outkicked for the minor placings. FORE HARP chased three wide, chased on the turn and tired. SPEED FIGURES showed good speed inside to set the pace, dueled with the winner on the turn and gave way in the stretch.
