LUCKY LOUISA set the pace on the inside rating comfortably, shook free on the far turn, responded when roused, opened up and was ridden out. TOO MANY MIKES tracked on the inside, bid two wide entering the far turn, then chased the winner, dug in inside in the final furlong, dueled for the place spot and got the nod at the wire. MIND BOGGLING raced off the pace inside, chased on the far turn, rallied three wide into the stretch, dueled for second and just missed at the finish. LA PLUMA steadied when crowded at the start, trailed the field, came three wide into the lane and failed to threaten. MIDNITE BUST R OUT stalked three wide, chased on the far turn and gave way. THEGANGSALLHERE stalked two wide, chased on the far turn and gave way. EASTER MILLIE hit the gate and veered out causing the rider to lose the irons and unable to recover, continued off the rail off the pace, dropped back on the far turn, was eased in the stretch and walked off. After a Stewards' Inquiry into the start, the race was declared official.
