SOUPER WILLIWAUW was bumped at the start, pulled for the opening half mile while tracking close up on the inside, continued inside, angled out at the quarter pole, rallied three wide into the stretch, closed willingly outside of the leaders, finished strongly, drew clear under urging and was in hand late. SOUPER ZONDA set the pace on the inside, dueled with CITY GIRL (FR) on the far turn, dug in gamely inside in the stretch run and finished well for place honors. CITY GIRL (FR) stalked close up two wide, bid two wide entering the far turn, put a head in front, dueled between rivals at the eighth pole and was outfinished. MIDWAY MEMORIES was bumped at the start, trailed the field, steadied on the first turn, raced two wide off the pace, dropped back on the far turn, then closed belatedly. MISCHIEF IN MOTION raced off the pace, three wide on the backside, chased three wide on the far turn and tired.
