VESPARO bumped at the start, raced off the pace between rivals, moved up inside on the far turn, rallied on the rail and drew clear under urging. DUMB MONEY bumped at the start, raced three wide early, then chased the pacesetter, moved up midway on the far turn, rallied three wide into the stretch and dug in gamely to the finish. WORD FOR WORD raced off the pace inside, between rivals on the far turn, rallied mildly in the two path and got the nod for third. GIANT JAMES trailed the field, advanced four wide on the far turn, rallied mildly outside and just missed for third. WILD JAIME bumped at the start, raced off the pace between horses and gained mildly on the rail in the stretch. WHAT'S UP MR. Z raced off the pace with a three wide trip, chased on the far turn, rallied mildly and was outkicked. JUST COMPLY showed good early speed, set the pace, dueled between rivals in upper stretch and weakened. PERROTTO was bumped at the start, pulled in the early stages, raced two wide off the pace and between rivals in the stretch run. GO TO THE KINGDOM bumped and steadied at the start, raced off the pace inside, three wide at the quarter pole and was in traffic in midstretch. PASSPORT steadied entering the first turn, raced off the pace inside, steadied on the far turn and did not factor. POST COMMAND bumped at the start, raced off the rail, off the pace and did not factor. DOIN THIS tracked inside and faded. OHANA EMPIRE raced four wide early, then three wide and gave way.
