Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

BRING ME A CHECK tracked close up on the inside, pulled while saving ground on the backside, bid two wide on the far turn, rallied outside of SHOGUN BE FAST in the final furlong, dug in gamely between horses in deep stretch and prevailed in the driving finish. BE HERE raced off the pace inside, moved

up inside on the turn, angled out at the quarter pole, rallied outside, dug in gamely in the final sixteenth and surged late outside rivals. SHOGUN BE FAST showed good early speed to set the pace racing with a clear lead, dug in gamely inside in the stretch run and battled on willingly to the finish. LEO MONTE raced off the pace inside, chased on the far turn, lacked a winning bid and finished evenly. DRAKON raced three wide off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and closed mildly. ZIPPY GIZMO was bumped at the start, raced three wide off the pace, chased four wide on the far turn, came wide into the stretch and closed mildly. AL AMEEQ was bumped at the start, raced off the pace between horses, saved ground on the far turn and lacked a rally. LONELY RIDE hesitated and was off slowly, outrun early and closed belatedly inside. BAR FOURTEEN stalked two wide, chased and faded. MT SURIBACHI bobbled and was bumped at the start causing the rider to lose the irons which he quickly recovered, then raced off the pace, off the rail and gave way on the far turn.
