KHETAM settled off the pace, bid between rivals midway on the far turn, took over, responded when roused, drew clear at the furlong marker and was kept to the task. SON OF A SLEW tracked close up on the inside, made a rail bid on the far turn, dueled briefly, angled off the rail at the eighth pole and continued willingly to the finish. FRATELLONE stalked close up two wide, bid four wide midway on the turn, chased rivals into the stretch and finished evenly. THINGAMABOB was off a bit slow, trailed the field, chased on the far turn, angled out entering the stretch and gained mildly outside. MORE POWER showed good early speed, set the pace racing with a clear lead, dueled between rivals on the far turn and gave way.
