MISS FOXANN tracked the early pace from between rivals, got shuffled back a bit heading into the turn, angled outside of rivals along the bend and was roused four wide to upper stretch, responded well into the drive then wore down foes into the final sixteenth and held well late for the win. GAMBLE ON LOVE bobbed then was crowded at the start and was last away from the gate, rushed up outside of rivals heading to the turn, vied for the lead three wide nearing the quarter marker, battled into the stretch and took a narrow lead at the furlong grounds, was outfinished in deep stretch and held well late for second. STYLE IN TIME raced close up to the early pace while between rivals, took back into the turn, rallied between rivals into the stretch, was gaining in the late stages and just missed for second at the wire. CHAPTER AND VERSE stalked the early pace from outside of rivals, went up and pressed from between rivals heading into the turn, battled between foes into the stretch, could not find more into the final sixteenth and yielded late. ROYAL ITCH broke alertly and assumed early command, set a contested pace into the turn, met oncoming bids into upper stretch, faded past mid-stretch and could not muster a final response. DARE ME tracked the early pace from the inside, got shuffled back a bit on the run to the turn, trailed to the quarter pole and came up empty in the stretch drive.
