BLUE MAX rated nicely off of the early pace, swung to the outside of rivals into the turn, was asked for run five to six wide to upper stretch, loomed into the lane then took command at the furlong pole, powered home in the late stages and drew clear for a convincing win. BOUDIN broke in at the start and was off a step slowly, was asked for early run and pressed the pace two wide into the turn, dueled for command three wide at the quarter marker, battled into the stretch, could not match strides with the winner heading to the final sixteenth but kept on to be second best. DREAM KNIGHT stumbled at the start and was off slowly, unhurried along the backstretch, coaxed outside of rivals along the turn then swung six wide to the stretch, needed more in the lane but ran on to get up for third at the wire. THANKS FRANK was hustled for the early lead, assumed command and set a pressured pace into the turn, dueled off of the rail nearing the quarter marker then battled from the two path into upper stretch, could not keep pace into the final furlong, faded late and was tagged in the final strides for third. MSHINDI settled in the early stages while not far back, was well placed while saving ground into the turn, could not find the needed response nearing the furlong grounds and gave way in the late stages. LAND MARK DEAL got shuffled at the start and broke a bit slowly, was unhurried to the turn, trailed to the quarter marker and did not factor in the drive. BUCKET LIST broke alertly, ceded the early lead then tracked outside of rivals along the backstretch, chased three to four wide heading to the quarter marker, could not keep pace into upper stretch then weakened in the drive.
