MOR STORMY away in good order, stalked the early pace three deep along the backstretch, went up and dueled for pace duties outside of VESPER MARTINI heading into the turn, dueled that rival to the quarter marker then shook free to upper stretch, kicked clear at the furlong grounds, drew off under steady handling and was ridden out in the late stages to win as much the best. HE'S MY BOY settled off of the early pace, was roused between rivals along the turn then ran in pursuit two to three wide to upper stretch, chased MOR STORMY into the final furlong, was no match for the winner into the final sixteenth but won the nod for second on the wire. MY VALENTINO rated off of the early pace, tracked the leaders while widest into the turn, chased four wide to upper stretch, was outkicked in the lane and just missed for second, while well clear for third. VESPER MARTINI sent to dispute the early pace from between runners, assumed command along the backstretch then dueled inside of MOR STORMY heading into the turn, contested the pace to the quarter marker, was repelled into upper stretch, could not keep pace with MOR STORMY into the drive and gave way. LITTLE SHANCE showed early speed and stalked the pace from the inside along the backstretch, was close up to the turn, chased from the inside heading to the quarter pole, could not find more to upper stretch and tired in the lane.
