RON DAH LOU broke alertly, chased the top pair three wide around the turn, drew on even terms nearing the quarter pole, battled outside rival into the lane, running on the wrong lead through the stretch, held on under an all out drive for the victory. IT'S BROWNS TIME raced off the pace into the turn, found best strides angling inside nearing the furlong marker, altered course once again tipped outside rivals in deep stretch, rallied with vigor just missed at the wire. SPECIAL COLLETTE sent out of the gate, inched clear mid-way around the turn, collared vied inside RON DAH LOU into the lane, battled into dep stretch, held on willingly to secure the show money. MOBIL DREAM STAR pressed inside around the turn, tipped out six wide for the stretch run, drifted out leaving the furlong marker, finished evenly through the wire. ELOPEDATTHEDERBY raced off the pace four wide around the turn, put to task seven wide through the lane, had no late punch. FOREVER FLOWING hustled up soon after the start, chased inside around the bend, under pressure turning for home, weakened through the stretch. HOLIDAY BETTY lacked speed into the turn, roused on off the pace into the lane, never threatened.
