SUZIE Q'S SISTER broke sharp, stalked the pace well in hand into the turn, given the queue leaving the three eighths post collared the leader two wide leaving the quarter pole, kicked away with authority for the score. TWIRLING LIGHT shut off at the start, trailer into the turn, found best strides seven deep nearing the furlong marker, rallied with good energy for the place award. THIS ONE'S FOR US away in good order, pressed the pace four wide around the turn, stayed on willingly for the show prize. DREMSCOMTRUBCSEOFU slammed back at the start, saved ground off the pace around the turn, bid evened out late after a very rough beginning. AMBER ROAD raced off the pace six wide around the turn, bid eight deep into the lane, running on the wrong lead, had no late punch. DON'T CALL ME BABE forced in at the start, swung out seven deep into the lane, under pressure leaving the furlong marker, weakened in deep stretch. COLLECTED MIST bore in impeded foes at the start, set the pace around the turn, collared quarter, gave way through the lane. BLONDIENESS raced off the pace five wide, eased through the lane, walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE START OF THE RACE, AFTER REVIEW THE RESULT STOOD OFFICIAL NO CHANGE.
